How to get there:

From Barcelona (El Prat) airport

		
<p>From T1 & T2 airport terminals.</p> <p>Taxis from Barcelona Airport offer their services 24 hours, waiting for passengers at the taxi ranks located on floor 0 in terminal T1, and outside the buildings, in terminal T2: T2A, T2B and T2C.</p> <p>A journey to the city center usually takes between 20/40 minutes.</p> <p>There are 3 fares depending on the daytime, but the minimum to pay is up from 20.00 €</p>	<p>From T2 airport terminal train to "Paseo de Gracia" station.</p> <p>From "Paseo de Gracia" train station:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Metro (Line 2) until "Monumental" station. 	<p>BUS (€5.90)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aerobús (A1) from T1 airport Terminal to "Plaza Catalunya" • Aerobús (A2) from T2 airport Terminal to "Plaza Catalunya" <p>www.aerobusbcn.com</p> <p>Total estimate time: 20-30 minutes.</p> <p>From "Plaza Catalunya":</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Walking (around 10-15 minutes) - By metro (line 1) until "Marina" station (3 stops)

From Girona airport

Some low cost Airlines will fly you to Girona Airport located near Girona city, 90 km from Barcelona. There is a bus 20-25 minutes after each arrival that will take you to the city on over 1 hour and 10 minutes and costs around €12.00. Final stop is "Bus North Terminal" (Estación del Norte)
