Levels of instruction: beginners, intermediate and advanced. Instruction will be available for participants who have never played shakuhachi, and who are commencing at the Summer School. Plastic beginners' instruments will be available for loan or purchase. PLEASE NOTE THAT INSTRUMENTS OF LENGTH 1.8 SHAKU WILL BE USED FOR ALL TEACHING. If you do not possess a shakuhachi of this length, you will need to obtain one before the Summer School, or borrow a plastic beginner's instrument at the Summer School.

<u>Arrival</u>: The Summer School will commence officially on the morning of 19th June 2014, at 9 am. It is thus recommended that participants arrive on the evening of 18th June 2014. Additionally, an introductory concert with the KSK teachers from Japan is being planned for the evening of 18th June 2014 (8 pm).

Departure: The Summer School will end at about 5 pm on 22nd June 2014. Participants may choose to depart on the evening of 22nd June 2014, or to stay overnight and depart on 23rd June 2014 (or later).

Fees: the fees, listed below, cover all group teaching, concerts (including 18th June 2014) and activities at the Summer School. Not included are accommodation and meals. Participants must organise their own accommodation - a list of hotels etc. will be available from January 2014. If sufficient interest is expressed (by checking the appropriate box in the registration form), the organisers will attempt to make a collective booking for rooms at hotels in Radolfzell. Meals can be obtained easily and cheaply at various cafes, bistros and restaurants in Radolfzell. It is likely that a hot canteen meal will be available for lunch each day at a very affordable price; please check the box in the registration form if you wish to make use of this option.

Participants who register early (before 1st April 2014) will obtain a discount. ESS members also obtain a discount. (Please provide your ESS membership number on the registration form.) Payment: a downpayment of €100 is required to secure your participation. For early registration, this must be received by 1st April 2014. For normal registration, it is required by 1st June 2014. In case of cancellation before 8th June 2014, this will be refunded, less a processing fee of €50. In case of cancellation on 8th June or after, the downpayment will not be refunded. The balance of the participation fee is to be paid in cash at the start of the Summer School.

Upon receipt of your registration form, you will be sent payment details for the downpayment.

Transport: Radolfzell has a railway station with good InterCity connections to Stuttgart, which is in turn internationally connected. The nearest large airport is Stuttgart; a small airport is located at Friedrichshafen, which connects by local train and/or ferry to Radolfzell.
